

Treasurer:

1. The current account balance stands at **£3062.71** (was £2543.26 in Nov 2014).
2. A SJC cheque for £667.05 has been made to the Inn-on-the-Lake for the SJC Xmas lunch balance. Cheques /cash totalling £817.50 received from members for this lunch.
3. The Xmas lunch raffle made £96.00 for club funds – many thanks to Gill and Pauline for organising this.
4. £12.00 of petty cash has been spent for 2nd class postage stamps for the membership renewal letters.

5. To date 22 members have paid their 2015 subscription fees, most at the Xmas lunch – many thanks to Moira for her help with this. A number of members pay via Standing Order in January and some of these are not yet included in this number.
6. The Solway Jaguar Club committee have discussed and agreed that Mr Paul Daniel Wiggins and Mrs Carolyn Heslop will be removed from the list of signatories to the Solway Jaguar Club's NatWest business current account in view of their leaving the Club committee. Mr Christopher Orr (SJC Treasurer) will remain a signatory and Mr Ray Page will become a new signatory to this SJC account.
7. Unfortunately the club Treasurer won't be available for the May clubnight (Tuesday 5/5/15) as he's attending a business conference in Manchester. This is the SJC 2015 AGM evening and 2 options are available. First is to change the AGM night - to either Thursday (7/5/15) or the following Tuesday (12/5/15). MAJOR JAGUAR GATHERING /“FATHER’S DAY” SHOW HAREWOOD HOUSE, 21 June 2015

In the absence, yet again, of a JEC Northern Day, the JEC Yorkshire Ridings Region is proposing that interested northern JEC regions/JDC areas support a pre- existing major classic car event at the excellent Harewood House venue (Leeds to Harrogate road A61/A659, near Wetherby) on Sunday 21 June, 2015. It is already a significant "Father's Day" general classic car event attracting nearly a thousand vintage & classic cars, with big clubs like Mercedes-Benz UK treating it as their major annual day. There is entertainment and a full arena programme, with prizes in many categories, is surrounded by motor dealer displays, car-related stands and collectibles, craft & specialist food stalls.



Major sponsor is the Yorkshire Post. Harewood House is one of the “Treasure Houses of England”; designed by Robert Adam & John Carr and built between 1759 and 1771. The spectacular interior features Chippendale furniture and Turner paintings, whilst the grounds were styled by Capability Brown. There are lakes with a water cascade and stepping stones, exotic bird garden (penguins, flamingos, parrots), tearooms, garden centre and extensive kids’ adventure playground.

For many years, JEC Northern Day at Harewood House was a true gathering of the regions including North East, Yorkshire, Cumbria, Lancashire, Derbyshire and Cheshire as well as some of the Scottish regions. We can support this show as a significant Jaguar/Daimler gathering in the expectation that it may lead to a replacement/re-instated JEC Northern Day. Apparently, tickets (at reduced prices) are purchased en bloc from the Yorkshire Post, so it would be a huge benefit if those interested would put their names forward.....all Jaguars & Daimlers welcome, no matter how old, or new. SPECTRE – The new James Bond Film car line up

On November 6, 2015, James Bond will return to theatres in Spectre and continuing Jaguar Land Rover's successful involvement with the Bond franchise, Jaguar C-X75, Range Rover Sport SVR and Land Rover Defender Big Foot are to feature in new James Bond movie, SPECTRE.



The Jaguar C-X75 will feature as the Bond villains car in a spectacular car chase sequence through Rome alongside the Aston Martin DB10, driven of course by James Bond.



Scenes including the heavily modified Land Rover Defenders & Range Rover Sport SVR have already been filmed in Austria. The Range Rover Sport SVR is the fastest and the most powerful Land Rover ever. The

highly capable Big Foots were constructed by the Special Operations division with huge 37-inch diameter off-road tyres to tackle the extreme terrain. They also feature bespoke suspension and enhanced body protection.

It'll be the 10th time 007 has driven an Aston Martin—he sported the classic DB5 in Skyfall, the same car Sean Connery's Bond drove in Goldfinger. Aston Martin is only making 10 DB10s, and none will be available for purchase by the public. It's unclear what will happen to these cars once the movie wraps up.

Roll on roll off – roll over?

Ever wonder what happened to the 1,400 cars stranded on the Hoegh Osaka on its way to Germany and the Middle East, but only got as far as the Solent?



It was carrying more than £60m worth of vehicles including 1,200 Jaguars and Land Rovers and 65 Mini cars, as well as 105 JCBs.

The 51,000-tonne vessel was towed to Southampton where it took dock workers almost two weeks to remove the vehicles from the ship.

Most were driven off under their own power but four remained and were so badly damaged specialist equipment was used to remove them.

Insurers are still assessing the damage caused to 1,400 luxury cars and heavy plant equipment she was carrying.

Looking at the condition of the cars that have been driven off of the ship, they appear to be in better shape than expected. Some have emerged completely unharmed, while others have suffered some body damage.

This has happened before. In 2006, the car carrier like the Hoegh Osaka developed a severe list off of the coast of Alaska. On board were 4,700 brand-new Mazda's headed for American dealerships. The ship's entire cargo of factory-fresh cars was crushed in scrap yards at a cost to its insurers of \$103 million.


